

SANTA BARBARA WOMEN'S GOLF CLUB

BOARD MEETING

June 2, 2010

The meeting was called to order by President Jackie Ewing at 1:40 p.m. at Mulligan's.

Present were Jackie Ewing, Kay Sharpe, Judy Borrell, Carolyn Nielsen, Ann Wunsch, Emily Dempster, Jan Brown, Paula Nelson, Belinda Salazar, Donna Dishman, and Susan Trenchel.

Susan Trenchel read the minutes from the March 24th board meeting. The minutes were approved as read.

Handicap Chair – Judy Borrell announced that the Most Improved Player for the months of March and April was Fumie Sato. The Most Improved Player for May was Kay Sharpe.

Judy said the Claire Ittner from Pub Links came to SBGC to rate the course after the improvements. We will be receiving a new handicap rating soon. Claire said that the Women's Club needs to decide where the red tee boxes will be for holes 16 and 17. Judy will ask the Pro Shop where the final position of the red tee box will be on hole 17.

Treasurer – Kay Sharpe said that the club has sufficient funds and she will prepare a financial report soon.

Tournament Chair – Paula Nelson said that she needs hostesses for one week in July and August 4, 11, and 24. Paula, Judy and Jackie met with Rich to discuss paying the pro shop to help with the pairings, score cards and leader boards when we have major tournaments (Turkey Shoot, Member/Guest, Grandmothers tournament and the Presidents Cup). Rich Barker will help with the Member/Guest Tournament on June 23rd. The Women's Club will pay \$75 for these services. Rich asked for a list with the player's names and their GHIN numbers before the tournament. Jan Brown will compile this list and a list of Women Club members who are playing and another list of the names of the non-members who are playing.

Jan presented two luncheon options to the board. It was decided by the board to get the lunch option that did not have a first course of salad. Jan will print instructions for the participants that include the closest to the pin holes, the longest drive hole, and local rules. The longest drive winners will be one person from each flight. The Women's Club is contributing \$700 to the tournament. Donna said that prizes will be given to the first three places from each flight for low gross and low net. The board discussed what the prizes should be and it was decided to buy gift cards in the pro shop that can be used for merchandise in the pro shop or green fees for the golf course.

Jackie said that the board should be at the course at 7:30 a.m. to prepare for the tournament.

Kay said that she will be running the 50/50 raffle and asked for volunteers to help her sell the raffle tickets. Belinda and Judy volunteered.

Pub Links Chair – Donna Dishman said that Santa Barbara Golf Club will be hosting the Pub Links tournament on Thursday July 8th. She asked for volunteers to help with the check-in and scoring. Belinda and Paula volunteered to help. She reported that the Pub Links Women's Championship will be at River Ridge Golf Course on August 16th and 17th. The cost for both days is \$185.00.

Old Business – Paula announced that Fumie Sato won the Pub Links Senior Tournament on May 17th at Oak Quarry Golf Course in Riverside.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:30 p.m.
