

**SANTA BARBARA WOMEN'S GOLF CLUB
GENERAL MEETING
NOVEMBER 8, 2006**

The meeting was called to order by President Sally Smith at 2:04 p.m. at Mulligan's. Approximately 40 members attended.

Sally welcomed back **Alicia Allison** who will be working in the Pro Shop and giving lessons for the next three months. Alicia said that she has some golf clinics planned for us after play and wants our ideas for more. She said that she would like to hear from us and that the shop has her phone number.

Kathy Crevier read the minutes from the last general meeting, and they were approved as read. Barbara Willett spoke up with an update. Since June she has agree to captain the A-team for one more year.

Barbara read the Treasurer's report. Total club funds as of October 31st are \$3,243.33. Barbara informed the membership that Publinks has raised the individual member fee from \$16 to \$20 per year. This fee is paid for each of us out of our dues by this club. This leaves us with \$4 less per member in our treasury for next year. If we have the same number of members next year as this, we need to cut our expenses over \$600. The Board is working on this and has decided that anyone who does not pay her **membership fee until after November 10 will be charged \$60.**

Barbara invited everyone to see the improved President's Cup which is on display in the breezeway.

Lynn Craig introduced the proposed tournament schedule for next year. Some tournament dates have been moved for various reasons. This is tentative because Richard Chavez has not yet approved it. Lynn said that she needs hostesses and is circulating a sign-up sheet. She promised to call those who signed up before their dates to remind them. She also invited everyone to the annual Xmas open house at Mary Kellogg's on December 5, the day before the Xmas tournament begins.

Jan Kelleway announced the winners and awarded the prizes for the Turkey Shoot which ended today.

Happy Schroeder announced the winners and awarded the prizes for the Low Net/Low Putt Tournament which was held last Wednesday.

Sally introduced some new members.

Sally read the proposed slate of office and committee chairpersons for 2007 (see attached) and said that most are the same as last year. A motion was made and passed to accept the slate as presented.

Mo Masson said that she will be representing us at tonight's Parks & Recreation meeting and would be glad to bring up anything we wanted.

Sally asked the membership to consider whether to cancel the member/guest tournament. Since this is a \$600 expense in our budget, canceling it would make up for the shortfall caused by the Publinks increase. This will be decided later.

Sally asked the members whether to **continue our website**. The Board has decided that we can afford to continue it for only one year at this time. It was moved to continue the website for one year. The motion passed.

Doris O'Brien invited us all to come to the club **Xmas party** which will be held December 13th at Moby Dick's. She asked us to send her our checks early, but promised not to cash them yet. Attendees will have their choice of three entrees, but do not have to pick until at the party. She said that notices about the party are by the computer.

Emily Dempster reminded everyone that **scores from today's Turkey Shoot should be posted in the computer as a tournament**. Anyone that did not should contact her and she will correct the posting.

Sally informed us that our **website has a message board** and suggested that we use it to find members to play golf with outside of our weekly club games.

Barbara informed the members that the **signup sheet for March team play** is posted in the Pro Shop.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:33 p.m.
