GENERAL MEETING

The meeting was called to order by President Paula Nelson at 3:02 at Mulligan's.

Present were Paula Nelson, Karen Robinson, Fumie Sato and Sharon De La Vega.

Joyce Rahm moved that we dispense with the reading of the minutes of the Feb. 4 general meeting. Seconded and approved.

Ann Durkee, Northern Rep. for Pub Links was in attendance and made a short speech offering help & advice if needed.

Sharon De La Vega reported on the Pub Links tournament that was held at Santa Barbara Golf Club on Thurs. June 11. We had 80 players from various golf courses that attended. She also reported that the Far Away Tournament will be held in New Orleans coming up soon.

Sharon also reported that she was trying to get another bulletin board put up by the computer so that we have more room to post upcoming events from Pub Links.

Chris Talerico, Director of Golf, spoke about the importance of keeping up with the group ahead of you. Educate yourself on ways to keep up the pace of play by being ready to hit when it is your turn and exiting the green as soon as possible after putting out. Record the scores on the next tee. He also reported that construction will soon start on hole #16. Two greens will be redone, #'s 5 and 11. There will be an all-day golf academy held on July 28. Instruction begins at 8:00 a.m. and will conclude with a round of golf at 1:00. The price is \$100. There will be a Ping Demo Day held July 23 & 27 from 10:00 – 1:00 conducted by Larry Buker of the Golf Shop. Women's Open at Sandpiper and Muni will be July 29 & 30, shotgun both days. He encouraged all members of the women's club to participate in this event. The Russ Morrison Tournament will be held Aug. 21. This will be a scramble with a junior golfer playing with each foursome. This is a fund raiser to support junior golf.

Tournament chair, Carolyn Nielsen, spoke about the President's Cup tournament that will have 4 weeks of qualifying in August. Everyone that qualifies will need to be able to play all of Sept.

The lowest 16 qualifiers will be eligible. You don't have to play all four weeks during the qualifying round to qualify.

Paula announced, in the absence of Judy Borrell, Handicap Chairman, that Sue Wilcox was the most improved player for May. She has \$12.00 placed on the books in the pro shop.

Fumie Sato, Membership Chair, announced that Nancy Le Borgne was a new member and played with us today.

In the absence of Kay Sharp, Treasurer, Paula reported that the balance as of April 30, 2009 was \$8,074.55. Total receipts totaled \$3,308.00 bring the balance to \$11,382.55. Total disbursements were \$4,388.83 which brings the total to \$6,668.77 minus team & hole in one funds.
