

SANTA BARBARA WOMEN'S GOLF CLUB GENERAL MEETING

Old Business – Carolyn Nelson asked for volunteers to help run the President's Cup tournament in September. The tournament qualifying rounds take place in August for three weeks. The top sixteen players from the qualifying rounds will compete in a match play tournament to win the President's Cup.

Richard Chavez spoke about an upcoming event to celebrate his retirement and the 50 year anniversary of the golf course. The Celebration Event will be held on Saturday September 13th and will cost \$50 per player. This fee includes a cart, lunch, tee prizes, and a cocktail party after golf. Past employees and some of the original members will be attending to celebrate the course anniversary and say good-bye to Richard. Richard also reminded everyone that they need to use any credit money they have in the pro shop before September 15th or they will lose it.
